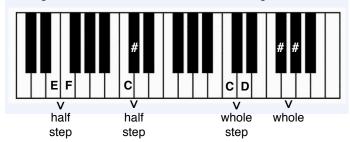
## **Beginning Piano Basics**

## Whole Steps & Half Steps

A half step is the distance between one note on the piano and the VERY NEXT CLOSEST note (i.e. C to C#). A whole step is the distance between notes equal to two half steps (i.e. C to D).



## **5 - Note Scales**

5-note scales are great 5-finger patterns that develop flexibility, agility, and key familiarity. The pattern for the scales is easily identified by the whole-step/half-step pattern of the five successive white notes beginning with C.

C - whole step - D - whole step - E - half step - F - whole step - G
